Thursday & Friday, December 6 & 7 – Robbie Blaha, Keynote Speaker (TSBVI)

Title: Exploring Appropriate Programming for Students with Deafblindness

This day and a half presentation will build participants' knowledge of the underlying impact of deafblindness in accessing essential environmental information needed for social engagement, incidental learning and communication development. Topics include strategies and adjustments that support their students' progress in the general curriculum and compensatory sensory skills.

By the end of the course, participants will be able to:

- Give examples of accommodations & strategies that would be appropriate for students with deafblindness who they currently serve
- Cite effective online resources for their educational teams to use in program development

Title: Hell-Bent on Helping

In this 75-90 minute presentation, Norm and Emma discuss how people with disabilities need respectful support and authentic relationships if they are to become valued members of our classrooms and communities.
